### Aerosoles



**Yes, please:**

- ✓ All aerosols (even harmless products like air since the container explodes if burnt or in metal recycling)

**No, thank you:**

- ✗ Other waste
- ✗ Gas bottles

What happens? Spring and safe disposal. Metal recycled.  
EWC-code: 08 01 11 Waste paint and varnish containing organic solvents or other dangerous substances.

### Batteries



**Yes, please:**

- ✓ All kind of service batteries

**No, thank you:**

- ✗ Other waste

What happens? Safe disposal and metals are recycled.  
EWC-code: 16 06 01 Lead Batteries.

### Cardboard



**Yes, please:**

- ✓ Boxes
- ✓ Cardboard
- ✓ Paper wrappings
- Office paper (small amounts)

**No, thank you:**

- ✗ Contaminated cardboard
- ✗ Plastics
- ✗ Newspapers

What happens? Recycling, becomes new cardboard. Keep dry if possible. If totally soaked dispose as general waste. If large amounts of office paper appears, keep separated due to higher quality.  
EWC-code: 15 01 02 Paper and cardboard packaging.

### Combustible



**Yes, please:**

- ✓ General waste, anything not hazardous that can be destroyed by fire
- ✓ "Drip-dry" oil containers

**No, thank you:**

- ✗ Materials usable for recycling
- ✗ Hazardous waste
- ✗ Landfill









What happens? When burnt the heat is often used for district heating. If general waste is burnt, wood in small amounts can be included, but using a separate fraction often saves us money.  
EWC-code: 17 09 04 Mixed construction and demolition waste (non-hazardous)  
20 01 99 Other fractions (non-hazardous).





 <p><b>Coolant liquids</b></p> <p><b>Yes, please:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Coolant liquids</li> </ul> <p><b>No, thank you:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✗ Other liquids</li> </ul> <p><small>What happens? Neutralized. EWC-code: 16 01 14 Antifreeze fluids containing dangerous substances.</small></p> <p><small>WARNING HAZARDOUS WASTE</small></p> <p><b>Vestas.</b></p>	<p>Coolant liquids MW05</p>	<p>30x20cm</p>	
 <p><b>Disposable/Landfill</b></p> <p><b>Yes, please:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Last option! When burnt the heat is often used for district heating. If no incineration (burning) for waste is available we might need to go for landfill, that is usually the case in Celtic and Poland.  <p><b>Electrical</b></p> <p><b>Yes, please:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Anything operated by wire or battery</li> </ul> <p><b>No, thank you:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✗ Other waste</li> </ul> <p><small>What happens? Shredded and metals are recycled. EWC-code: 16 02 13 Discarded electrical and electronic equipment (hazardous), 16 02 14 As above but with no hazardous materials (non-hazardous).</small></p> <p><small>WARNING HAZARDOUS WASTE</small></p> <p><b>Vestas.</b></p>	<p>Electrical MW07</p>	<p>30x20cm</p>	
 <p><b>Fluorescent tubes</b></p> <p><b>Yes, please:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Long straight tubes</li> <li>✓ Compact light tubes</li> </ul> <p><b>No, thank you:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✗ Other waste</li> </ul> <p><small>What happens? Shredded and hazardous substances are stored secure. EWC-code: 20 01 21 Fluorescent tubes and other mercury-containing waste.</small></p> <p><small>WARNING HAZARDOUS WASTE</small></p> <p><b>Vestas.</b></p>	<p>Fluorescent tubes MW08</p>	<p>30x20cm</p>

 <p><b>Metal and Cables</b></p> <p><b>Yes, please:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ All metal (oil parts shall be "drip-dry")</li> <li>✓ All cables</li> <li>✓ Barrels and container</li> <li>✓ Empty paint cans (not cleaned, minimal contents) can be metal waste</li> </ul> <p><b>No, thank you:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✗ Any packaging with remaining chemicals is hazardous waste</li> </ul> <p><small>What happens? Recycling to new metal. Can be sent back in Tool Container from smaller construction sites. EWC-code: 17 04 07 Mixed metals.</small></p> <p><small>Vestas.</small></p>	<p><b>Metal and Cables</b> MW09</p>	<p>30x20cm</p>	
 <p><b>Oil Filters</b></p> <p><b>Yes, please:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Oil Filters</li> <li>✓ Other oily materials with mainly metal content</li> </ul> <p><b>No, thank you:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✗ Other waste</li> </ul> <p><small>What happens? Shredded and materials recycled. EWC-code: 16 01 07 Oil filters.</small></p> <p><small>Vestas.</small></p>	<p><b>Oil Filters</b> MW10</p>	<p>30x20cm</p>	
 <p><b>Oily Products</b></p> <p><b>Yes, please:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ All burnable material stained with oil / grease like rags, paper, grease tubes, absorbents, empty oil containers, oily soil etc</li> </ul> <p><b>No, thank you:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✗ Other waste</li> <li>✗ No material contaminated with fuel since that is more flammable, store separate</li> </ul> <p><small>What happens? Burnt in specific plants, energy used for heating. If more than a shovel of oily soil appears, handle separated and contact OSE. EWC-code: 15 02 02 Absorbents, filter materials, wiping cloths etc. contaminated with dangerous substances.</small></p> <p><small>Vestas.</small></p>	<p><b>Oily Products</b> MW11</p>	<p>30x20cm</p>	
 <p><b>Paint</b></p> <p><b>Yes, please:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Remaining paint, hardener and thinner</li> <li>✓ Dry paint</li> <li>✓ Brushes, rags etc with paint</li> </ul> <p><b>No, thank you:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✗ Empty cans (not cleaned, minimal contents) can be metal waste</li> </ul> <p><small>What happens? Burnt in specific plants, energy used for heating, metal recycled. EWC-code: 08 01 11 Waste paint and varnish containing organic solvents or other dangerous substances.</small></p> <p><small>Vestas.</small></p>	<p><b>Paint</b> MW12</p>	<p>30x20cm</p>

 <p><b>Unsorted</b></p> <p><b>Yes, please:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Not the preferred option! Only if other fractions are not suitable</li> </ul> <p><b>No, thank you:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✗ Hazardous waste!</li> </ul> <p><small>What happens? Unsorted replaces all other non-hazardous fractions, but is not the preferred option since we throw it all in one bin and pay for separation afterwards. It is usually expensive and the quality of segregation is not as visible to us. If used, we need to get the information back regarding waste amounts and fractions after segregation. 17 09 04 Mixed construction and demolition waste (non-hazardous).</small></p> <p><small>EWC-code: 17 09 04</small></p>  	<p>Unsorted MW13</p>	<p>30x20cm</p>	
 <p><b>Waste Oil</b></p> <p><b>Yes, please:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Waste Oil (all oil coming from Vestas serviced turbines)</li> </ul> <p><b>No, thank you:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✗ Waste oil not coming from turbines (due to risk of unknown contamination and PCB)</li> <li>✗ Oil mixed with water, fuel or other</li> </ul> <p><small>What happens? Recycled and used for new oil products. Sometimes burnt.</small></p> <p><small>EWC-code: 13 02 08 Other engine, gear and lubricating oils.</small></p>  	<p>Waste Oil MW14</p>	<p>30x20cm</p>	
 <p><b>Wood</b></p> <p><b>Yes, please:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Wooden pallets</li> <li>✓ Other wood and timber (metal share is allowed)</li> </ul> <p><b>No, thank you:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✗ Painted wood (not in "composites")</li> <li>✗ Pressure-treated wood (send as "hazardous waste")</li> </ul> <p><small>What happens? Burnt or reused. Sometimes disposed of locally, that is OK but notify GSE and report quantities quarterly.</small></p> <p><small>EWC-code: 17 02 01 Wood</small></p>  	<p>Wood MW15</p>	<p>30x20cm</p>
